We were once again awarded a silver medal by EcoVadis in 2023, which means that we rank among the top 15 percent of all companies assessed.

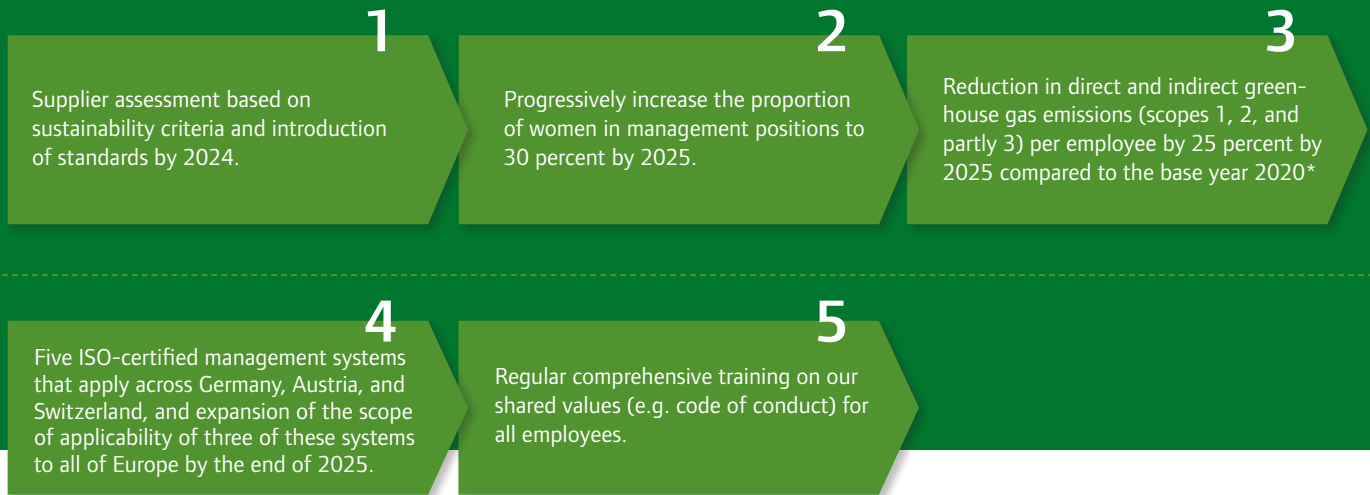
The CHG-MERIDIAN Group is a leading global technology2use company in the IT, industrial, and healthcare sectors.
